#### PFA FUNDS

I am delighted to inform you that the Summer Fare raised a staggering £3793.86. I am sure you would all agree it was a FANTASTIC afternoon, thank you to all the volunteers and staff who helped with set-up/stalls and packing away.

The PFA have funded our fantastic astro-turf underneath our adventure playground (£3,456) and have purchased a multi-sensory teaching resource 'Numican' which enables children to see how they can add, subtract, multiply and divide numbers and the relationships between these. They will be used in classes from Nursery to Reception to support with our commitment to teaching children maths skills using concrete apparatus.

## Play Equipment/Scooters/Bikes/Safety

School adventure playground equipment **should not** be used before or after school by siblings or school children. Please ensure your children are with you at all times and under your supervision to safeguard them on the school site. To enable us to safeguard and protect children in afterschool clubs/Birches club we would be grateful if you can leave the school site promptly as soon as you have collected your child/children. A final bell sounds at 3.25pm to indicate the gate will be locked. Thank you for your co-operation with this.

Everyone should push scooters and bikes until they are out of the school grounds and take care around pedestrians on the way home.

Whilst you are waiting for the gates to open in the morning please ensure your children are standing next to you. Staff have reported several concerns of children running up and down the path and to the entrance door. This is to ensure the safety of your children especially when cars are entering the premises. Thank you for your understanding.

## Penalty Notices for Absences from School

I am receiving many more holiday requests from parents to take children out during term time. Our School Attendance figures have reduced significantly. Please take time to read the information below to make informed decisions as holiday request will be unauthorised and may lead to a penalty notice in 2019/20.

# If your child is absent from school please notify the school office on the first day of absence.

Recent guidance has been published outlining action that should be taken to address unauthorised absence and/or persistent lateness. It states that a penalty notice can be issued following;

The FIRST Instance of 20 plus sessions of unauthorised absence within a 12 (or less) school week period OR

The FIRST Instance of 10 plus sessions (U code) lates within a 12 (or less) school week period .

N.B. I session = 1/2 a day (a morning or afternoon session)

Absence can only be authorised in exceptional circumstances.

Please consider the impact any time off school can have on your child in terms of missed learning.

Thank you to all the parents who do commit to their child's education and ensure they are punctual every day. The teachers and I are very grateful.

## Harvest Assembly

We will be celebrating harvest at our Harvest assembly on **Tuesday 22nd October at 2pm** for parents of children in Reception to Year 4. (One parent per family please due to H&S regulations).
