## **MULTI FAITH DAYs**

Children and staff are looking forward to celebrating our Multi Faith days next week. This year, we will be celebrating Diwali on Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> October. During the day the children will take part in a range of activities as they learn about the festival and how it is celebrated by people of Hindu and Sikh faith.

On Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> October the children will be finding out about a range of religions including Christianity, Islam, Buddhism and Sikhism, focusing on symbols of faith, rituals, stories and places of worship. We hope that the children will enjoying finding out about a range of faiths, reflecting on their own beliefs and developing a deeper understanding of the value of diversity in our society and the importance of respecting the beliefs of others. (Children in Year 3 will take part in activities in class on Tuesday due to their school trip on Thursday)

## On Wednesday 23rd October, the children are invited to come to school dressed in traditional or bright and colourful clothing.

At the end of the day on Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> October (weather permitting) we would like to invite parents to join us on the playground from **2.50pm** as the whole school perform some Bollywood dancing following their workshop during the day.

After the bell has gone, we will be holding a Diwali stall selling items such as samosas, cupcakes and Indian items. All money raised will go to the Hope & Compassion - Children in India Project; please give generously.
