The Well provide food parcels and essentials for those in desperate need across the city of Wolverhampton. This year, we would once again like to assist those less fortunate than ourselves. In collaboration with the Bilbrook Community Nursing team we are holding our own version of The Well's Reverse Advent Calendar scheme.



We are inviting families that are able to do so, to donate an item from their class' list of requested items. Once collected, the School Council and Mrs Nickolls from the Community Nursing Team will use the items to create hampers to be donated to The Well who will pass them on to those most in need.

We are inviting donations of the following items from each class;

Nursery: UHT milk, shampoo, tea, jam,

Reception: tinned carrots, UHT fruit juice, toothpaste, cereal,

Year 1: tinned meat, noodles, toilet roll, shower gel,

Year 2: coffee, tinned peas, squash, tinned fish,

Year 3: marmalade, rice, tinned tomatoes, pasta sauce,

Year 4: tinned potatoes, deodorant, gloves, warm hats.

Children in Year 4 will also be writing a card for each hamper to share Christmas blessings from Birches with those who receive the gifts.
