Dear Parents,

Rehearsals are now well underway and the school is, once again, filling up with Christmas songs! Our Christmas performances will be taking place from the second week of December.

Information can be found below regarding tickets and the performances for your child's year group. Information about words, song words and costumes will be sent home by class teachers.

This year we would once again like to offer the chance for siblings to come and watch the children's performances too. Therefore, we will be holding a more 'relaxed' performance which will be open to extended family and parents wishing to bring along pre-school siblings. To ensure the success of such a performance, please do consider other audience members, and if your younger sibling becomes upset or restless during the performance, we ask that you take them out until settled so as not to distract the children during their performances. Younger siblings do not need a ticket but will be required to sit on parents laps. (No pushchairs or prams please.) The other performance for each Key Stage will be for adults only – no babies or younger siblings please.

We will not be allocating physical tickets for the performances but payment via ParentPay will confirm your allocation and will be added to the ticket list for your chosen performance. Two tickets for each performance will be allocated per family at a cost of £2.00 each. We would like to be able to accommodate everyone who wants to attend so a reserve list will be kept for one extra ticket per family. Please leave your child's name and the preferred performance date with the office. To be as fair as possible to all parents who request a reserve ticket, names will be placed in a pot and drawn at random.

Morning nursery children are invited to come back for the afternoon performance – parents should drop children off shortly before the start of the performance and collect again at the end.


Wednesday 18th December – including end of term awards; 9.30am (Parents only – no babies or siblings please.)
