Online Safety



A reminder to please be vigilant and monitor the content of all games and adverts that children may be exposed to when using tablets, phones, computers and games consoles, as well as ensuring TV programmes and films watched are suitable for children. The content of TV

programmes screened later in the evening is unlikely to be suitable for children of the ages attending Birches so please consider this before recording programmes shown after bedtime for your child to watch the next day. Film ratings indicate the suitability of a film's content for it's audience. IMDb provide a useful 'Parent's Guide' for films which gives information about the film's content in a number of categories to help parents make safe, informed choices for their children's viewing . A reminder that **PEGI** ratings are in place to safeguard children and children should not play or be exposed to (including by watching older siblings play) the content of games that are rated above their own age. It is advised that children only play online games in shared family areas, rather than on their own in bedrooms to enable parents to be able to supervise their child's play and safety.
