Year I Visit to Warwick Castle

During this term our topic is 'Brilliant Britain'. To enhance and aid the learning objectives throughout this term, I have organised a visit to Warwick Castle on Thursday 30th January 2020.

We will be stepping back in time and learning about castle life with an interactive workshop.

We will depart from school at 9.00am and will travel by coach fitted with seatbelts. We will return to school in time for the end of the school day.

As your child is entitled to a free school lunch, we are able to offer each child a simple packed lunch. However, please feel free to send your child with their own 'treat' packed lunch and drink (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks please) in a small, lightweight backpack that they are able to carry themselves. Should you require a school packed lunch, this must be ordered at the office by 9.00am on Friday 24. January.

Children will need a warm coat, hat, scarf and gloves. They should wear their Birches polo and jumper as usual but may wear jeans and comfortable trainers suitable for walking.

The cost of the trip would have been £24.00 per child. This covers the cost of the coach, entrance to the castle and the workshop led by the castle guides. However, the PFA have kindly donated £200 to reduce the cost to £17.50. We are requesting payment to be made through ParentPay. When you make the payment, you are giving permission for your child to attend the trip. Should you wish to pay by PayPoint please contact the school office who will be able to provide you with a barcode.
