Please find your child's home learning grid uploaded to the website. The grid is split up into the seven areas of the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS). A new grid will be uploaded each week. The activities are for you to access as you wish, in you own time and in any order. I will still upload one daily challenge per day to promote their basic skills as before.

Monday-PE

Tuesday-Mark Making

Wednesday-Mathematics

Thursday-Funky Fingers

Friday-Scissors

In the EYFS all learning is interwoven and overlaps into all other areas of development. The grid has an activity that may have a stronger focus within that one area but will inevitably link with many other aspects of the EYFS.

All the activities promote secure learning and understanding. Each activity can be encountered and engaged with differently depending on individual needs and learning styles.

The activities can be extended to promote challenge and to further enhance their skills. Please email me for further ideas to support with any of the activities. I am happy to provide advice for children who may struggle with or would like to extend their progress further.

PLEASE read the phonics guidance I have uploaded. It is crucial we don't rush children through their learning. As they are all learning from home it is important, we do not create gaps in their knowledge, understanding or development.

Children learn best through hands on, creative, engaging and enjoyable experiences. They need time to develop their gross motor and fine motor skills whilst having rich experiences and good communication with others. Opportunities to ask questions and find out new information whilst learning through trial and error activities will certainly embed some wonderful secure learning experiences.
