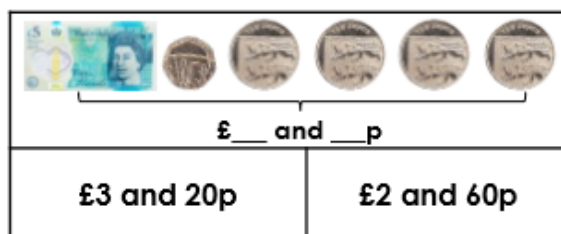
Maths

ninety-nine pence.

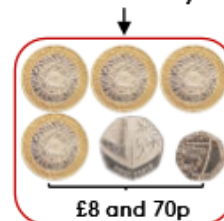
How much more money does Jamie have

Kim's money

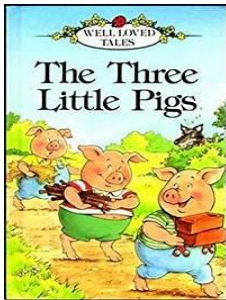

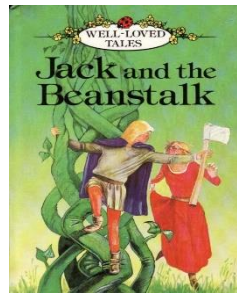
