### Maths Task (Geometry – Properties of shape):

#### Lines of symmetry

When a shape has a vertical line of symmetry, you can draw a line down the image which divides the shape into two identical halves. If a shape is symmetrical it is the same on both sides of the shape.

Please note: we are only expected to find the vertical line of symmetry at this stage (not more than one line).


## Challenges: Investigation time!




**Challenge 1:** Which flags can you find that have a vertical line of symmetry? You may want to use the flags below or find your own.
