Today we will look at comparing two different values in either pounds or pence. We will recap our learning using vocabulary of greater/ less than and use the inequality symbols (<, >, =).







<u>Task:</u>

1. Which is the greatest amount of money in each pair?




2. Write <, > or = to compare the amounts.





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
Use < > or = to compare their totals.

Infer the feelings of difference characters. Write their thoughts in a thought bubble. Think carefully about how they may be feelings and how this would affect their thoughts.


Listen/ read each part in the story again to help you. Write out the character's name with the thought bubble in your book.
