2nd Make the phonics letter using playdough, foil, paper, string etc.

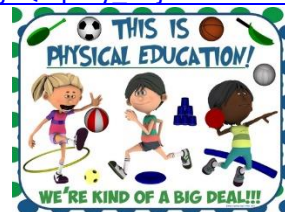
3rd Write the sound (grapheme)

Monster Feelings

- Look at the feelings cards (online or printed out)
- Practise making the face for each feeling
- Choose a card but do not show anyone! Make the face for the feeling on your card. Can your family guess the feeling?

Take it in turns to make the face and guess.

Other ideas:

- Can you match the monster feeling cards with the emoji feeling cards?
- Memory game- Turn them all over and find the matching pairs.
- Snap- share them out, turn them over onto a pile- shout snap when they match.

It's good to talk and act out feelings. Discuss with your child how we can show our feelings with body language, tone of voice or words we might say. Feelings are never bad!!

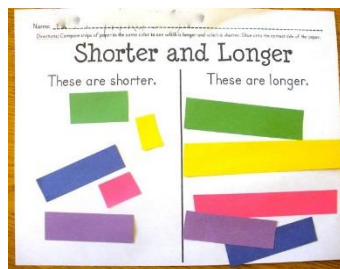
Mathematics
