





Maths Task (Multiplication and Division):

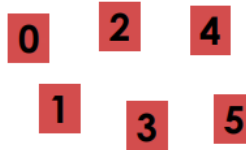

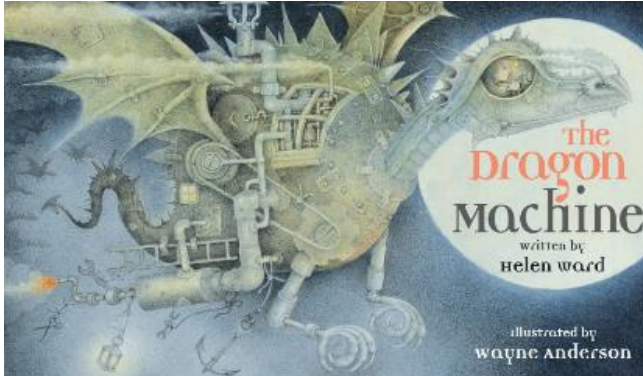
