<u>Maths</u>

Today we are going to be learning to use non-standard units and apply this to measuring, using a ruler.

- 1. Find a ruler or tape measure
- 2. Find an object
- 3. Measure with your ruler or tape measure
- 4. Record your measurements

What do the numbers on the ruler mean? (1 cm etc.)

Where should we place the object to start measuring it? **Remember to start from zero** and not at the end of the ruler.
