Current Funds

- Current funds are £6849.45.
- We agreed that we would purchase reception bags and 4 iPads for the school. We have also given a cheque for the Year 4 hoodies.

Fundraising Ideas

- We discussed holding a weekly lottery. We have located a site www.your-school-lottery.co.uk which will run this for us. For every £1 ticket sold, the school will gain 40p. There will be a weekly winner and a chance to win the jackpot of £25000 each week. Everyone seemed to like this idea and it would be a constant bit of income for the PFA fund.
- We agreed to hold a treasure hunt around the village for children to take part in during the summer holidays. We agreed that the children will find teddies in shops

and businesses and write what colour bow tie they are wearing on their entry sheet. The hunt would end at Spangles where children will get a bag of sweets and a link to print off a certificate for completion. Mrs Ferretti suggested putting all entries into a draw at the end and one winner wins a bigger prize. We have purchased a large teddy bear which will be the prize for this event.

- We discussed holding a virtual family festival where families can purchase a pack from us to hold their own camping/festival event at home. We will set up a zoom call so the children can dial in to chat and have a dance with their friends. Jenny M will approach one of the local singers to see if they can perform a set via zoom. We agreed on Saturday 25th July to hold this event.
- We agreed that we will still hold a Christmas raffle even though it will be unlikely any Christmas performances will go ahead.
- We discussed a bottle tombola over the Christmas period but will have to follow guidelines closer to the time.
- We agreed to having another Krispy Kreme sale as this was so successful. Hopefully in September or October.

Ways of collecting money

- We discussed that we probably need to set up alternative payment methods to ensure that we can still get maximum ticket sales when we hold events. People will be more reluctant to pay with cash at the moment due to the current situation.
- Selina is going to set up a PayPal account for the PFA and we also discussed possibly using Eventbrite if needed for events.
- We also discussed having a JustGiving page to raise money for laptops which are needed in school. This gives people a chance to donate at any point in the year.

AOB

- We agreed that we would help fund new laptops as these are needed for the next academic year.
- We also agreed we needed new gazebos but they are not a priority at the moment. However if we see any good deals, we will purchase if funds allow.
