Food Technology

Research the food that was eaten during the Iron Age. Create your own Iron Age recipe. Either bring in an example of what you have made or take photographs. Remember to write the recipe down.

Health and Wellbeing

Create a leaflet for 'How to survive the Stone Age.' Imagine you are transported back to the Stone Age and need a guide to help you survive. What would the guide say? What tips would it have? How can you stay safe? Use ICT if you wish.
