We have explored Kapla planks during our STEM day as part of Dyslexia Awareness Day. The children were challenged to balance the Kapla planks to create the tallest tower. Some children found this very tricky and challenging. We reflected this in our discussion whilst thinking about others who may find activities (such as reading) tricky.



The children have been introduced to Tommy Two from Ten Town. We have explored some of our Maths resources: 'Numicon' and counters. We sorted the 1 & 2 Numicon pieces and placed the correct number of counters in each basket. We have been learning to write the number 2, make marks to represent the amount and match the numeral to each basket.
