Year 3 Class Curriculum Newsletter – Autumn Term 2 2020 Mr Jones



Thank you everyone for making the first half term so successful after having such a long time away from school. Everyone has come back really settled and have been keen to do their best in their lessons. This term we are going to be continuing with the majority of things that we implemented in the first half term. In class we are using 'Class Dojo' as a way to encourage children to participate in class discussions and to maintain their top level of behaviour. The children with the most points (dojos) at the end of the week is crowned that week's winner, and then the points are reset and started fresh the following week. After reviewing the base line assessments and discussing it with fellow KS2 staff, we have decided to start our spellings this half term, focussing on high frequency words. These will be tested every two weeks and will be sent home in a spelling test book. We ask that this book comes back into school on the day of the test.

Games will continue to take place on Tuesday afternoons and PE is still scheduled for Thursday afternoons. Please could you continue to send your children into school, already in their PE kits, on these days.

Please remember that all children should bring a water bottle into school every day. If you have forgotten a water bottle we can provide a disposable cup, however, it is down to the children to notify us that they haven't got their water bottle at the start of the day.

English

In English this half term we are going to be progressing on to different types of texts and looking at how they are written.
