



Dear Parents,

As you may be aware, World Book Day will be celebrated on **Thursday 4th March**. This day is an opportunity to celebrate the rich and wonderful world of books and promote a love of reading.

Understandably, this year's event will be somewhat different but I'm sure we will all have lots of fun!



On this day, teachers will be setting World Book Day themed tasks via Teams for those children at home as well as for those attending school. Please see below further information about ways the children can get involved;

Dress as an adjective.

We are not asking children to dress up in costume as a book character or within a particular theme this year. However, children are invited to join their class Teams meeting on Thursday 4th March (Nursery, Reception, Year 3 and Year 4) or Friday 5th March (Year 1 and Year 2) dressed as an adjective. This can be as simple or creative / adventurous as you want to make it! We do not want parents to feel we are expecting extravagant or expensive outfits! You could choose 'stripy', 'spotty' or 'colourful' or perhaps

Create a scene / character from a book.

'awesome', 'interesting' or 'creative'.

We are inviting children to get crafty and decorate a potato / dress a potato as your favourite book character.

Or,

Create a 'Book in a Box'. Decorate a shoebox or similar to recreate a scene from the story of your favourite book. Why not combine them both and put your potato character into the box?!

Create your own 'Book Awards'.


Which book would be awarded the prize for;
