Of course, we still need to know of positive cases after 4th April. However, for cases that occur between 5th April and 18th April, please simply notify the office, <u>office@birches.staffs.sch.uk</u>, informing us of the date of the test and the return date of your child. No other member of staff needs to be contacted. We will respond once we re-open on the 19th April.

Obviously, should your child need to isolate we need to be made aware and support you with appropriate schoolwork from the start of the new term.

Additionally, during the Easter holidays we are having some extensive work carried out on our car park. The car park will be re organised and a new pedestrian walkway will be created along with new entry and exit gates. I will communicate with you as soon as I possibly can regarding any changes to drop off and collection procedures –the site will look very different I am sure!

Finally, I hope that you enjoy some family time and manage to catch up with friends and family as we are be able to do more. I look forward to hearing from the children when we return about some of the activities that they may have re-engaged and participated in...I know I have a very excited little boy who cannot wait to start football again on Sunday with his friends!
