School Site

As previously communicated, during the Easter break substantial work has taken place to our school site. A new pedestrian entrance and pathway with a barrier to the car park has been created along with a new exit from the school site to the pavement. We have had fencing erected around the whole perimeter of the school and automated gates controlled by school. I am sure when you see the transformation you will agree that it looks amazing and a sense of safety created. Please read the following for arrival/dismissal procedures....

Birches Club Marning and Afternoon

For both Morning Drop Off and After School Collection please access the school via the pedestrian walk way (following the red barriers) to the main school entrance. Once at the main entrance please press the intercom for the attention of the Birches Club Staff. The staff will ask which child/ren is arriving/being collected and then will proceed to come to the Main Entrance Door to greet you and your child/ren and take them to club or bring your child/ren to you at the end of the day. Please exit school via the pedestrian walk way.

School Arrivals/Departures

As there is a red barrier between the car park and path we are unable to have two lines for the EYFS/KSI/KS2 Bubbles. The pedestrian pathway is however, long enough to accommodate two year groups-ONE AFTER THE OTHER. This will mean that for both drop off and collection parents must line up in the following order:

Nursery 8.30am/3.00pm	Reception 8.30am/3.00pm
Y1 8.35am/3.05pm	Y2 8.35am/3.05pm
Y3 8.40am/3.10pm	Y4 8.40am/3.10pm

There will be signs and staff out in the morning to inform you where to stand. Please stand to the left (against the barrier) so that if a Nursery, YI, Y3 parent needs to walk past to line up at the front with their cohort they can do so with minimal contact.

The exit route will be the same as before however, you will exit at the bottom right of the field through the new gate anto the pavement -please use both paths on the daily mile to ease congestion. Again, staff will be there to guide you at the end of the day. Please note, as you are exiting straight anto the pavement I ask that you remain vigilant and children remain walking next to you so they do not run anto the road.

Cycle Rack/Bikes/Scooters

As you will not be able to re-enter school once you have exited scooters/bikes will need to be taken with you to collect your child/ren from the storage rack on entering the grounds.

Children are not permitted to ride on scooter/bikes on the school premises. This is due to the legalities of Health and Safety Law. I would appreciate your cooperation with this as always, thank you.

Attendance-Reminder

Please remember to notify the school office if your child is absent from school. Birches continues to work with an independent Education Welfare Service 'Attend' to support and maintain our commitment to outstanding attendance at Birches.

School Fund and Nursery Fund

Thank you for your School Fund donations. These donations of £1 per week provide vital funding for the wide range of extracurricular activities and events we are proud to be able to offer. School fund contributions can be paid via ParentPay. Thank you.

Lunchboxes.

Birches is a Healthy School and we would like to remind parents that lunch boxes should contain a healthy balanced meal of a sandwich, a yogurt/ yoghurt drink, a snack size chocolate bar/biscuit, a savoury snack, fruit and a plastic cup for a drink. Children should not bring sweets, drinks, smoothies or large chocolate bars. As always, school will provide water for your child,
