
Year 1 Class Curriculum Newsletter – Autumn Term 2 2021 Miss Owen and Mrs Kandola

English

In English this term we will be reading a range of texts to develop pleasure in reading. We will retell and role play a range of traditional tales including Goldilocks and The Three Bears, The Gingerbread Man and The Three Billy Goats Gruff. Instructions

Arts / Design Technology

As part of this topic the children will be learning about structures and constructing windmills.

<u>Religious Education</u> – Belonging - We will be learning about special ceremonies and sharing special moments.

Computing - Grouping and Sorting/ Lego Builders.

<u>Music</u> – Learning new songs and exploring a range of percussion instruments.

Humanities

Our topic will give opportunities for the children to: learn about the weather and seasons. We will be looking at weather forecasts, maps and how the weather affects us in the U.K. We will be learning about extreme weather and hot and cold climates. We will observe and measure the weather.

Maths

Our focus for this half term with be Subtraction, we will then move on to recognise and name 2-D and 3D shapes. Place Value within 20 – tens and ones, comparing and ordering numbers. Shape, position, and direction – describing turns and position.

Science / STEM

The children will be identifying and naming a variety of everyday materials including wood, plastic, glass, metal and rocks. We will describe, compare and group objects together using their properties. The children will look at materials suitable for a range of purposes.
