English

In English this term the writing genres will include stories with familiar settings and instructions. The texts will include Not Now Bernard, The Perfect Pet and The Tiger Who Came to Tea.

The children will be retelling stories, describing characters, and changing part of the story.

Writing instructions.

Music – Pitch and Tempo Identifying high and low sounds. Exploring instruments.

Arts / Design Technology Sculptures and Collages

The children will be learning how to plan, design, and evaluate their work as part of the design process. They will select their chosen methods and resources as they design their own product before creating and evaluating their final piece. We will be exploring collage techniques and 3D models.

History/Geography

This term we will be comparing everyday lives with parents/Grandparents. We will be finding out about the history of transport. our school, changes in communication, toys in the past and the seaside past and present. We will be learning about domestic life and the changes in clothes and hairstyles.





Maths

This half term we will be working on addition and subtraction to 20 using a selection of concrete resources including a part-whole model. We will be practising our number facts/bonds to 10 and 20. The children will apply their knowledge to problem solving and reasoning. We will move on to place value to 20/50 then Fractions, finding a half and quarters of a quantity.

Science / STEM

We will be learning about animals, with a particular focus on how to care for pets and other animals in different ways. We will identify a range of animals and pets, observing how they grow. We will discover the basics of genetics, by studying characteristics that animals gain from their parents. We will find out about different species, care, and preservation.

Throughout the term we will continue to observe and compare seasonal change.
