Maths

Find the lengths of the world's 5 longest rivers. Write the lengths in order from shortest to longest.

A river's depth relies on rainfall. Use a 2-litre plastic bottle with the top cut off to make a rain gauge. Keep a record of the amount of rainfall over 4 weeks. Present your findings using a graph. At a river's estuary people enjoy sailing. Draw some symmetrical designs for a sailing boat sails.

Create a questionnaire with tally marks to record the favourite sea creatures of your friends and family – then draw a graph to show the results.

English

Write a story with a river or rainforest theme. Maybe there is a river monster, or the river creatures come to life! Use your imagination.

Learn about the water cycle on the Internet then make a comic strip version of the water cycle. Could a water droplet be your main character? Write a poem about a river or river creature.

Design a brochure persuading people to visit a seaside town or village.

<u>History</u>

Research how rivers and canals have been used in the past?

Science

Investigate the water cycle. What happens? Draw a labelled diagram to explain.

Investigate rainforest animals and their habitats. Can you create a diagram of the different areas they live in?

Geography

Produce a fact file (this could be a PowerPoint) on 3 world rivers. Include as many interesting facts as you can. Label the longest river in each continent on a map of the world.

Art and Design

Draw or paint pictures of 3 different creatures found in a river or rainforest habitat. Label the features that allow them to live where they do e.g. a frog has webbed feet.

Create a collage using recycled materials of something to do with the rainforest e.g. a waterfall, river creature or river scene.

Make a 3D landscape model of a river or rainforest.

Make a model of a boat. This might be a sailing dinghy, barge, canoe, tanker or any other boat you might find on a river or ocean.

Physical / Health / Wellbeing

Create an informative poster teaching people how to be safe around rivers.

Create a leaflet about a healthy lifestyle. What should we do to keep our body and mind healthy?

Music

Using the tune of a well-known song of your choice make up your own river song. Create a rain maker using small pebbles or seeds. Could you decorate using a river theme?

Puzzles / Games

Create a wordsearch of the worlds Rainforests and famous rivers.

Create your own Top Trumps style cards with rivers/ rainforest animals/habitats
