
I would like to congratulate England Olympian, Mr Buckley (Ours Games Teacher) for competing in the


Christmas Parties Tuesday 13th December

tree within the church. The event will take place from Friday 9th -Sunday 11th December if you wish to go and view Birches' Christmas tree alongside others.









Carols Around the Tree Friday 2nd December 7pm

I am fully aware of the current financial climate and how parents are cutting back on some of the additional experience such as theatre visits etc. I hope that the


children enjoy this experience and remember it fondly.

First School/Middle School Admissions 2023 REMINDER

Please be aware that the School Admissions Application System opened on 1st November 2022 for First and Middle Schools. Staffordshire Y4 parents should have received an Admission Letter for Middle School 2023. If you have not had this; please contact the office.

You should only use this system if your child lives in **Staffordshire.** The closing date is **15th January 2023**.

Please note if you reside in Wolverhampton, please contact Wolverhampton Admissions directly.

Please note that children who currently attend our school Nursery will need to apply for Reception 2023/24. Admission to the Nursery class does NOT guarantee a place in the Reception class; a separate application must be made which will be subject to the admissions criteria.

Nursery September 2023/2024

Applications opened 1st September 2022 until 24th March 2023. All applications should be delivered to Birches First School Office marked Nursery Admissions 2023. Offer letters will be posted to parent/carers on 17th April 2023. An application form can be found on our website.

Current Nursery 2022/2023

We currently have availability for both morning and afternoon sessions, please contact the school office. We can take children as soon as they are 3 years old (charges apply) and also offer 'Rising 3' provision (funded from the term after their 3rd birthday) so your child may start our Nursery after the date of their 3rd birthday. Attendance-Reminder

Further to last month's Newsletter parents will be notified if their child's attendance is below 90% at the end of the school term (December 16^{th}).

If you received a letter regarding your child's attendance for the first half term (September-October) and this has not improved, we will be inviting you into school for a supportive meeting to discuss your child's attendance. I am fully aware that there have been an extraordinary number of colds/infections and genuine illnesses, but as a school after Covid we are required to monitor attendance much more carefully. The meeting is to talk through any issues and support parents if needed.

Further to this we have noticed an increased amount of lateness, please ensure your child is in school by 8.40am as this impacts their learning. Thank you.



Inclement Weather

If it snows heavily this winter, school closures will be decided on a local school group basis and announced on local radio from 7.00am onwards. Therefore, if any Codsall schools are mentioned it will mean all Codsall and Bilbrook schools, including Birches are closed. We will also text all parents if school is closed so you can be sure to

know what is happening.

Please be assured that should school remain open following snow fall, Mr. Tomkinson will grit the following areas: the path to the playground, the entrance to the main school building, toilets and mobile from the playground. The path at the back of the school leading to Year 1 will also be gritted but, please take extra care when collecting children from Year 1 as this path can remain slippery. Do take care in icy conditions in all areas of the school site and ensure that children are well supervised and also walk sensibly.
