#### Double the fun ...

**2 sessions per months will now be the norm!** No more thinking is it one or two this month, we are moving to giving children with SEND who access Aiming High Short Breaks 2 sessions per month. We have done some analysis of the attendance - actual places available to book compared to actual attendance and we have found we have places that are not used or booked, so to make sure children and young people have access to short breaks, we are opening these up from March. This will also help us in our mission to have online booking, as there will be consistency, and the providers who we are speaking too, say it will be easier to put into place. Double the fun ... 2 sessions per months will now be the norm!

So, from the  $1^{\text{st}}$  –  $10^{\text{th}}$  you can call up to book two free sessions and then after the  $11^{\text{th}}$  to book additional sessions which may be charged. We will review this at the end of March and April to check our systems are working and that there are not too many issues. It may be that we have to look at ensuring there is a fair spread of bookings for our providers who get booked up straight away – by limiting them to one free session and another free one at another provider, but we will wait and see.

#### Bookings via the SEND booking line ...

From March when you call up to book, some of the providers and activities may be by **Expression of Interest.** Some of our providers have sessions which are really popular and generate waiting lists, so from March some of the activities you call to book will have an Expression of Interest list. The providers will then get the list and contact you to confirm the booking, this means they can keep the list and follow up with to:

- To confirm your place
- To check any medical or risk assessment needs
- To talk to you about their other activities
- To check if your child needs a 1:1 place, 2:1 place or any additional needs (many of the providers offer 1:1 support but need to know this before your child attends, the more we know the better we can support, and needing a 1:1 or 2:1 space is not going to stop us trying to ensure your child and you have a short break)
- To check nearer the date that you still are available to attend
- Offer out any cancelled places to the others on the waiting list
- To ensure there is a fair spread of accessing their sessions
- To hopefully avoid the non-attended booked places

We will trial this for March and April and see how it goes. So, for any activities that the SEND booking team say are **Expression of Interest**, you will then get a confirmation call from the **Provider to confirm your place**.




