English

This half term we shall be covering a range of fiction and non-fiction units. We shall be focussing on writing stories based on stories we know that have familiar settings and will also be working on writing diary entries based on important days, such as Easter and our school trip.

History

Our History unit this term will be focussing on 'The Monarchy'

This will involve us looking at Key members of the monarchy, looking at who the most significant monarchs in the UK have been.

This will include us looking at Queen Elizabeth I, Queen Elizabeth II and the coronation of Kings Charles III.

Maths

During Maths this half term, we will be focussing on measurement (mass and capacity) and multiplication and division, looking at the 2s, 5s and 10s. This will also involve the children learning about 'sharing,' as a stepping stone into division.

Arts

We will be looking at the effect of craft and design, looking at different matters of weaving.

Music

We will learn how to identify high and low notes and to compose a simple tune, explore different instruments and investigate how tempo changes help tell a story and make music more exciting.

Science / STEM

Science this term will focus on plants, looking at the parts of a plant and how the parts help a plant survive and reproduce. We will also be covering seasonal changes between Spring and Summer and looking at the key differences between the two seasons.

Religious Education

Answers: Looking at religious stories that believers tell to each other and looking at the morales of these stories.

Computing On Purple Mash this half term, we will be covering coding.

PE / Games: Skipping/ Athletics/ Playground games

PSHE: Me in the World: Children will be looking at money and the benefits of both spending and saving.
