We would like to be able to accommodate everyone who wants to attend so a reserve list will be kept for one extra ticket per family. To be as fair as possible to all parents who request a reserve ticket, names will be placed in a pot and drawn at random.

Please can I remind parents that this performance is an adult only performance and any children with siblings at school will have the opportunity to see Nursery's performance.

At the end of the performance, I will be handing out certificates for selected children. At Birches we award a certificate for 'Gold Expectations' and 'Effort and Improvement' at the end of each term for children who staff believe deserve this extra special recognition. Please note as a nurturing school this isn't always for the one who is the most able, it can be a child who has worked incredibly hard, a child who has found something very difficult and persevered, it is for those children staff feel truly deserve it, not just ability recognition. You will be notified personally if your child is to receive an award, please do not let your child know as we like it to be a surprise for them!

The PFA will be selling ticket for our Christmas Hamper Raffle at all the performances...Good Luck! Costs are £1 a strip.

Morning children are required to come back to school at 1.15pm on both Wednesday the 13^{th} and Friday 15^{th} December so we can change them ready for the performance. If you wish your child to stay for lunch (additional cost) please inform the office to make arrangements. At the end of the performance, children will be able to leave school with you.

Finally, in line with our Safeguarding Policy and GDPR regulations, photos and videos of your child for personal viewing may be taken during the performance. Please remember however that any images or video clips should not be shared on any social networking sites, thank you for your cooperation.
