As part of our aim to help our children be healthy, safe and responsible, we teach Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHEe) lessons in school. As previously communicated, Relationships and Health Education is also a new **compulsory** part of every school's curriculum. PSHEe and RSE are taught throughout the school in every year group and gives children the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills they need to manage their lives and contribute positively to society.

In our upcoming lesson regarding 'Safety and the Changing Body', Year 4 will be focusing on several aspects of the human body.

Healthy eating Physical activity Dental health - hygiene Importance of sleep Medicines Tobacco – tobacco, smoke, non-smoker Alcohol First aid - asthma

Safety and the changing body

Online safety – age restriction, law, private, public, protect Safety around adults – private, public, protect Understanding their body Physical changes during puberty – breasts, genitals, penis, testicles/testes, hips, waist, shoulders, chest hair, puberty, hygiene Emotional changes during puberty Asking for help when needed

You only have the right to withdraw your child from the sex education content that we choose to teach.
