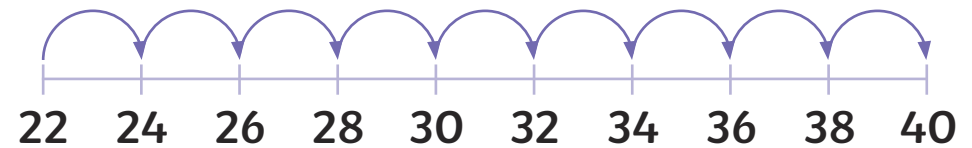


Count In 2s

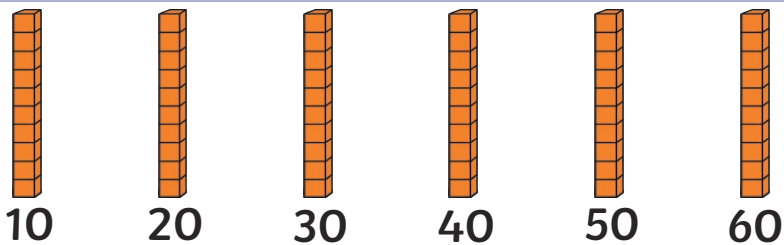


There are 5 pairs of socks.

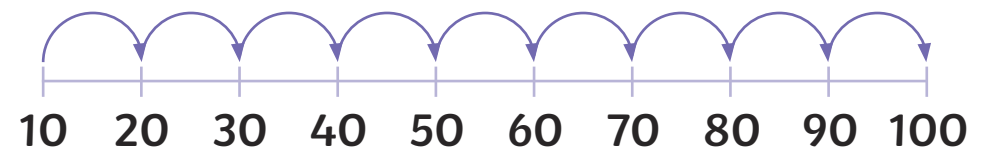


Count In 10s

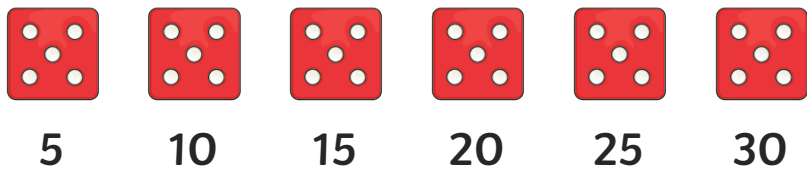


There are 6 groups of 10.

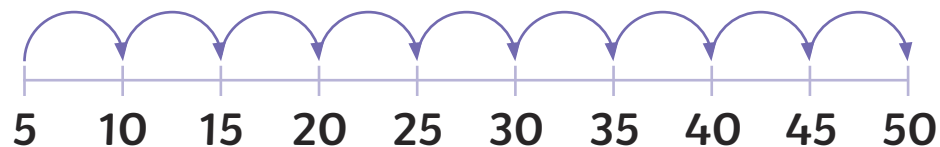


Count In 5s

There are 30 in total.

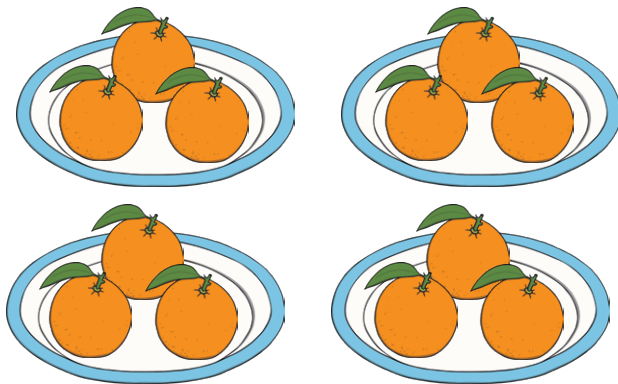

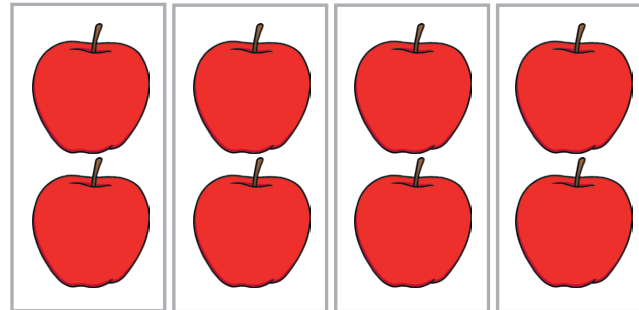
Recognise Equal Groups



There are 4 equal groups of 3 oranges.

Add Equal Groups

There are 4 groups of 2 apples.



$$2 + 2 + 2 + 2 = 8 \text{ apples.}$$

Make Arrays

There are 2 rows of 5 bread rolls. There are 10 bread rolls altogether.



There are 5 columns of 2 bread rolls. There are 10 bread rolls altogether.

Group Equally

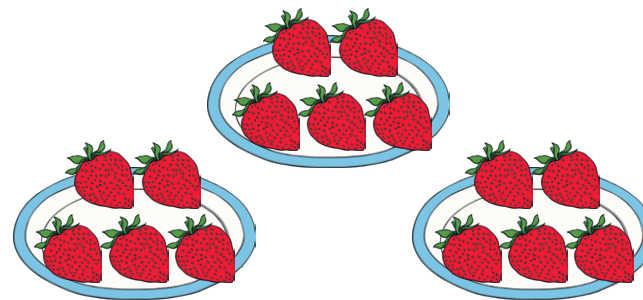
Put the shoes into groups of 2.



There are 3 equal groups of 2.

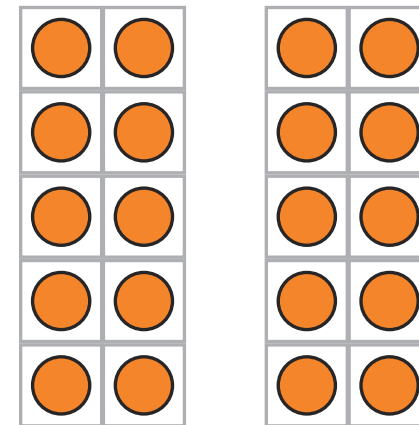
Share Equally

Share the strawberries equally into 3 groups.



15 shared equally between 3 groups is 5.

Make Doubles



$10 + 10 = 20$
Double 10 is 20.
