As part of our Religious Education (RE) curriculum, the children have been learning about a range of religions and their traditions, practices, worships and ceremonies. To support and enhance the children's learning, Year 3 will be visiting the **Guru Nanak Sikh Gurdwara on Tuesday 17th June 2025**. This enhancement opportunity will allow the children to develop a deeper understanding of Sikh traditions, practices, worship, and ceremonies.

Children will be travelling by bus and arriving at the Guru Nanak Sikh Gurdwara for 10.30am. They will be returning to school for their afternoon lessons. Please send your child to school with a packed lunch on this day which will be eaten in school on their return.

The children should wear their **games kit** and a waterproof coat due to walking to and from the bus stop. As a respectful gesture and in accordance with the dress code, when entering the Gurdwara, each child is requested to **bring a scarf/bandana to cover their head**. Please ensure that an item as such is brought to school on this day. The dress code also requires children to fully cover their legs when visiting the Gurdwara, please ensure **joggers are worn** on this day as part of the games kit.

The cost of the visit is **£10.00** including bus fare. Payment for the visit is to be made through ParentPay by **Friday 13th June 2025**. When you make the payment, you are giving permission for your child to attend the visit and go on the bus.
