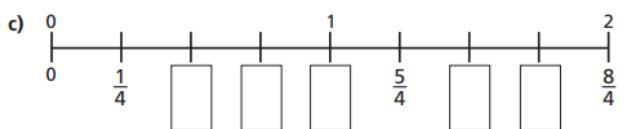
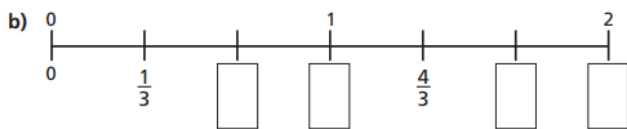
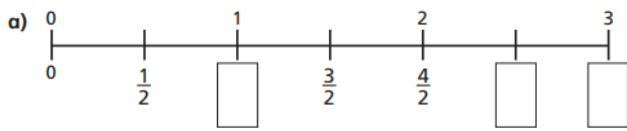

2. Write <, > or = to compare the fractions.

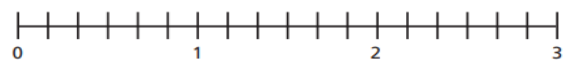
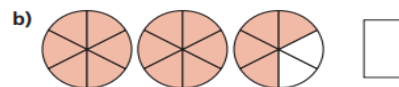
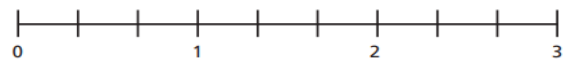
a) $\frac{1}{2}$ ○ $\frac{1}{4}$
