- 2 Use Jack's method to work out these divisions.

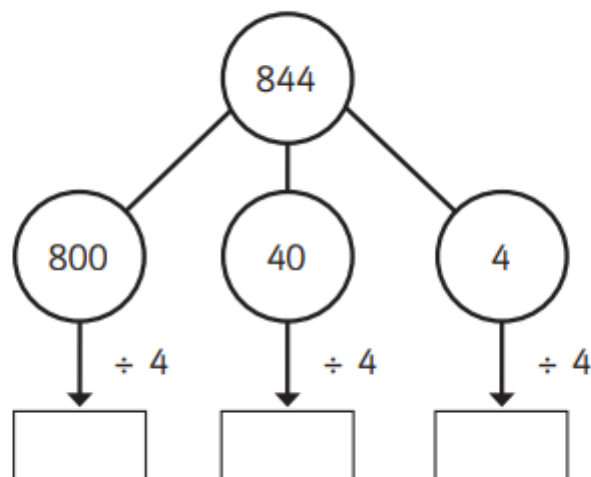
a)  $525 \div 5 = \square$
