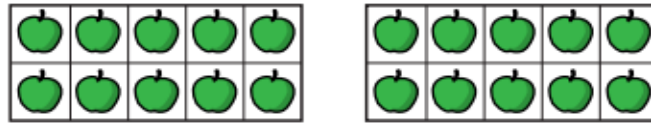

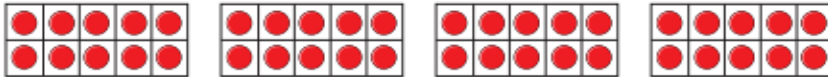


There are apples on each ten frame.

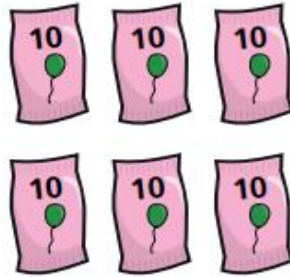
