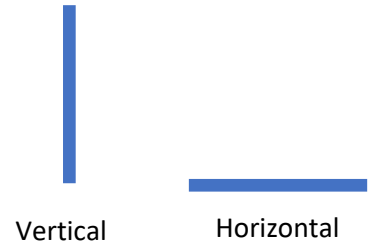

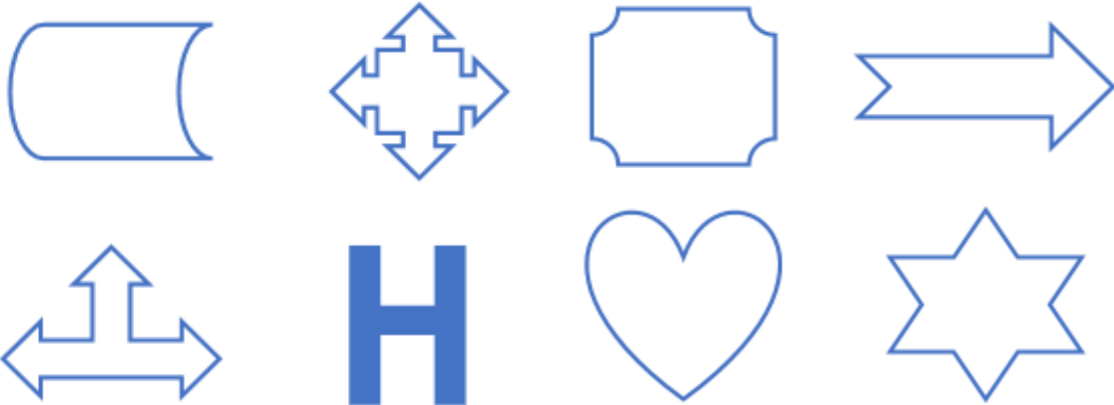

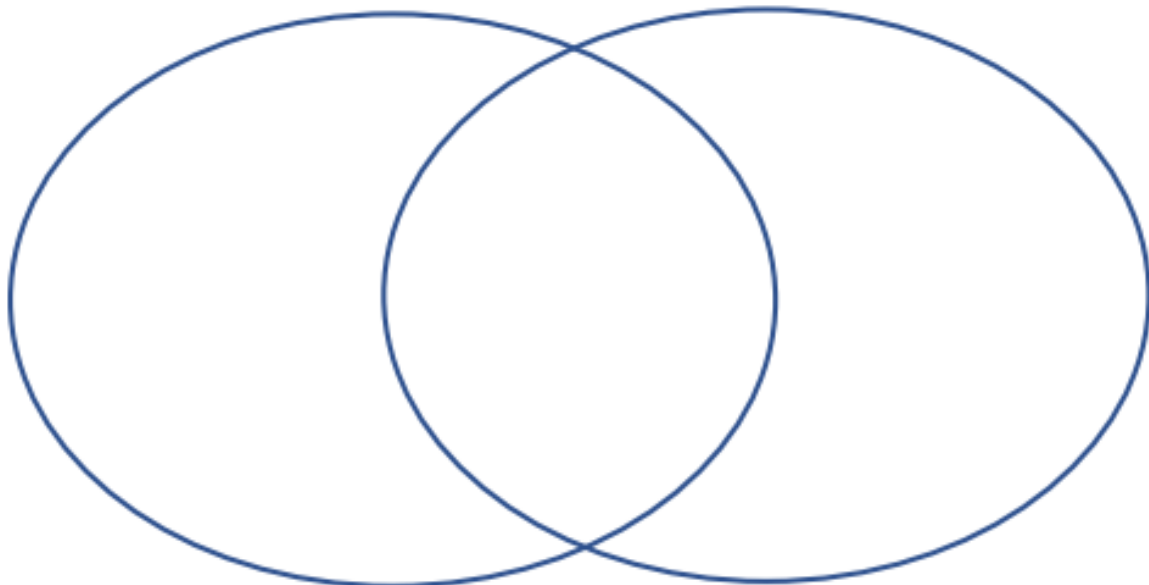

and staggering about.

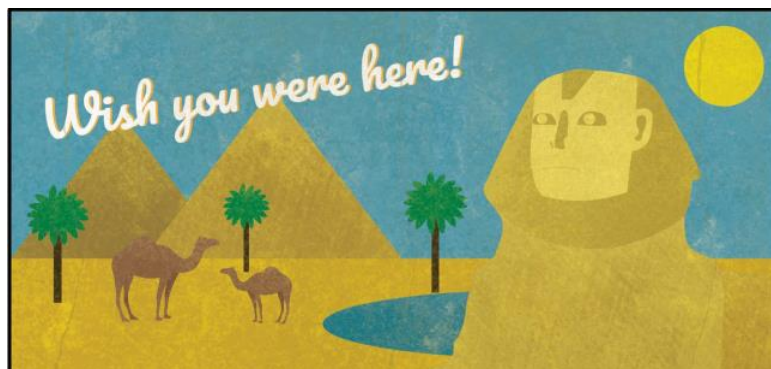
None of us moved to help him
